This includes supporting listening sessions for women at Bayer which, in turn, has informed our own company approach to gender representation and equity at work.
- International Day of Rural Women: Bayer is proud to promote the role of women in agriculture and rural Australia. On 13 October, Bayer hosted an online panel event to celebrate the role that women play in rural and regional Australia. DiALP graduate Dr Kelly Pearce was a great contributor to our panel.
- Active Farmers: We are a proud partner of Active Farmers, which provides group fitness services to country towns throughout regional Australia.
- **Big Fish Challenge**: The Bayer Big Fish Challenge is a friendly fishing competition for teams of rural Australians to raise awareness
