



What's happening at AgXchange?

Telstra will be running the [MobileMuster](#) recycling program at their stand during the upcoming NFF AgXchange event on the Gold Coast. It's a great chance to have a clean out at home and know your old tech products are being recycled sustainably and safely.

They'll have a dedicated recycling box at their stand, making it easy for attendees to responsibly recycle their old tech products. To make it even more exciting:

- The person who brings in the most eligible tech products will win a special prize.
- Everyone who drops products into the recycling bin will go into the draw to win a prize.

Tech products accepted for recycling include:

- All brands and models of mobile phones
- Mobile chargers and accessories (SIM cards, phone cases, and batteries)
- Wearables including smart watches and fitness trackers
- Mobile wireless Wi-Fi devices (dongles)
- Modems and routers
- Home landline phones
- TV streaming devices (Apple TV, Amazon Firestick, Google Chromecast)
- Apple, Amazon, and Google smart speakers and smart digital hubs

IMPORTANT: Before you recycle, sell or give away your mobile phone, you should remove your personal information. If your mobile phone is still working watch our 'How-to' videos and follow our steps for managing data on your [Android](#) or [iOS](#) device. You can also [see how to block your IMEI](#) so your device cannot be resold. If your phone is damaged and you're unable to remove the data, as part of the recycling process MobileMuster will destroy any data on the device. Your data will never be accessed.
